

CHRISTIAN PAHUD FIRST AND SECOND AT KENTUCKY SPEEDWAY

Harrisburg, NC ó Team Full Throttle NASCAR Driver Development racer Christian Pahud continues to accumulate podium finishes in the INEX Legends cars, as he walked off with Saturday's victory at the Kentucky Speedway and then lost one of the closest Legends finishes in the history of the division when Daniel Hemric nipped him at the finish line by just two-thousandths of a second on Sunday in the Young Lion National event.

Pahud credited Dan Snyder with once again giving him a setup that was nearly unstoppable. "When Dan puts a car on the track, it is always capable of winning," the 14-year old 2007 Lowe's Motor Speedway Summer Shootout Semi-Pro Champion said after Sunday's race. "He's taught me a lot about driving a Legends car. It was fun racing with Clay Hair and everybody in the other divisions on Saturday, and we were fortunate enough to get the win. Today, I had a fast enough car to win, and was able to open up a two or three car length lead over Daniel but we kept having caution flags that closed us back up. At the end, I just dropped the left front tire off the edge of the track a bit too much and when I had to check up, Daniel closed in and got underneath me coming through three and four. Neither of us knew who won until the track reviewed the finish. Daniel's a good friend and a good competitor. I was happy for him but disappointed I made the mistake that cost us the victory."

The win was Christian's eighth victory on the season, with the majority of them coming at Kentucky. He's never finished lower than third at the track. Pahud isn't really sure why that's happened, but says he does enjoy running there. "Dan has a great setup for Kentucky, so I'm sure that's a lot of it. Thomas Hartensveld always ran well there, and we just started running the KOIL Tour races earlier this year and adapted very well. I like the track. It's almost like our home track even though we've moved to North Carolina now. I look forward to racing at Kentucky whenever I have the chance."
