PAHUD RACING DOUBLEHEADER AT CONCORD AFTER 2 SECONDS LAST WEEKEND

CONCORD, N.C. – Christian PaHud will return to Concord Motorsport Park this weekend for the last two legends car races of the season at the track's quarter-mile oval. PaHud will race Friday night followed by a Saturday afternoon race to close the Fall Series for INEX legends cars.

The 15-year-old Harrisburg, N.C., racer will be looking for his first win of the Fall Series this weekend following two second-place results there last Friday and Saturday.

“I hope we can get a win this weekend; we should have had it last Friday night but we lost it with a few to go,” Christian said. “We led 21 of 25 laps and went into Turn 1 a little too hot and slid up the track and Daniel (Hemric) got under me. I tried to get him back but he was strong.

“On Saturday we started last in the feature and made it up to second in five laps. We didn't have enough to run down Daniel. We'll give it our best shot again this weekend.”

PaHud has finished either second or third in nearly every race this fall at Concord. He is currently seventh in Pro Legends national points out of over 250 entrants.

Christian PaHud is one of the top legends car racers in the South. He and his family moved to the greater Charlotte area prior to the 2007 racing season and he immediately began winning races in INEX legends cars. He won the prestigious Summer Shootout semi-pro legends car championship in 2007 and is currently racing for an INEX national championship in the pro legends car class.

PaHud is a member of the Team Full Throttle NASCAR Driver Development Program and is represented by Driver Development Services, Inc., Charlotte, N.C. His marketing partners are Kyle Beattie Racing, RPM Race Cars, and C&S Auto.

Team Full Throttle is a Mooresville, N.C., based driver development program that specializes in all areas of personal and professional development, including leadership, teamwork, and communications as well as marketing, promotion, and on-track driving skills.
