## **PAHUD ANTICIPATING 2009 LIMITED LATE MODEL CAMPAIGN**

HARRISBURG, N.C. – After two fall races in an Orion Motorsports-owned limited late model stock car, Christian PaHud is anticipating a full season in the class in 2009. In fact, PaHud's family went ahead and bought the car Christian recently raced at Southern National (N.C.) Raceway Park and are in the midst of preparing it for the '09 season.

Christian, who will turn 16 on April 9, plans to compete weekly at Tri-County (N.C.) Motor Speedway to begin the '09 campaign. If results are encouraging throughout the early part of the season, the team will plan on traveling to Hickory (N.C.) Motor Speedway, in addition to other Southeast short tracks.

The car PaHud will drive was recently rebuilt by Hedgecock Racing and will be numbered 63. The car will continue to be fielded and maintained out of the Orion Motorsports' shop in Taylorsville, N.C.

Christian PaHud is a 15-year-old racer originally from Dayton, Ohio, and now residing in Harrisburg, N.C. PaHud spent the last two seasons competing in the INEX legends car class, winning the prestigious Summer Shootout semi-pro legends championship at Lowe's Motor Speedway in 2007. PaHud will race a limited late model stock car in 2009. He finished fourth in his stock car debut in a 150 lapper at Tri-County on Nov. 1, 2008.

Christian is a member of the Team Full Throttle NASCAR Driver Development Program and is represented by Driver Development Services, Inc., Charlotte, N.C. His marketing partners are Kyle Beattie Racing, Orion Motorsports, RPM Race Cars and C&S Auto.
