PAHUD 15th TO SECOND FRIDAY, WINS SATURDAY

JACKSONVILLE, N.C. – Team Full Throttle NASCAR Driver Development racer Christian PaHud and his Kyle Beattie Racing team continued their travels to different Southeastern legends car tracks over the weekend.

Friday night the team made the trip to North Carolina's Caraway Speedway where PaHud started 15th and finished second in the 20-lap INEX Legends car feature. Saturday, PaHud won the Pro Legends car class in the 25-lap feature at Coastal Plains [N.C.] Raceway after racing side-by-side with his teammate for 14 consecutive laps.

“We went into the weekend wanting to do well, but really wanting to keep the car together with the Summer Shootout [at Lowe's Motor Speedway] coming up,” PaHud said. “We got disqualified after the heat for being two pounds light, so we had to start last in the feature. Parker [Hammons, PaHud's teammate] started back there with us so I basically followed him through the pack until he got into an accident. After that I raced really hard with a few cars and made it up to second.

“Saturday at Coastal Plains Parker and I ran side-by-side for a ton of laps and I just got him at the line to win the pro class. It was a fun race; Coastal Plains is a tough track because there's hardly any straightaway. We're pretty happy with the weekend.”

Tuesday night PaHud and his team will be at Lowe's for a practice session in order to prepare for the annual INEX Summer Shootout beginning Tuesday, June 10.

PaHud is the defending semi-pro legends car shootout champion and again has high aspirations heading into this year's 10-race series on the quarter-mile oval at Lowe's.

“We want to win the pro championship and win as many races as possible.”
