PAHUD GETS LEGENDS CAR WIN FRIDAY AT CARAWAY

ASHEBORO, N.C. – Christian PaHud won the 25-lap pro legends car feature at Caraway Speedway Friday night. Starting third, PaHud ran second for most of the race before getting the lead on a late-race restart and led the remainder of the event.

“We only got three laps of practice,” PaHud began. “We qualified sixth and they had the top-six qualifiers draw for (starting) position and I drew third so we got a decent starting spot. We ran second for most of the race and ended up getting the lead after a restart. We held on from there. It was good to get the win at Caraway. There’s always a good field out there and tough competition to race against.”

After Friday night’s event, PaHud and his Kyle Beattie Racing team travelled to Virginia’s South Boston Speedway for their Saturday 25-lap legends car event. PaHud qualified second, only five-thousandths-of-a-second off the pole time. He took the lead on the start and led the opening 18 laps of the feature before getting tagged from behind and spinning out. He finished seventh.

“I love that track,” PaHud said, speaking of South Boston. “It was my second time there and we really get around it well. We led the most of the race and ended up getting spun. We got back up to seventh and that’s where we ended up. We definitely had a really good car; I wish we could have ended the race clean and we probably would have been two-for-two on the weekend.”

The Ohio native will compete Tuesday in the sixth round of the Quaker Steak & Lube Summer Shootout at Lowe’s Motor Speedway. The Ohio native currently sits 10th in Pro Legends car point standings with three top-10 finishes.

Christian PaHud is a former WKA National Champion. He and his family moved to North Carolina prior to the 2007 racing season and he immediately began winning races in INEX Legends cars. He won the prestigious Summer Shootout Semi-pro Legends championship in 2007 and is currently racing for the Pro Legends car championship in the ’08 Summer Shootout.

PaHud is a member of the Team Full Throttle NASCAR Driver Development Program and is represented by Driver Development Services, Inc., Charlotte, N.C. His marketing partners are Kyle Beattie Racing, RPM Race Cars, and C&S Auto.
