

## CHRISTIAN PAHUD FINISHES FOURTH SUNDAY AT BRISTOL

BRISTOL, Tenn. – Team Full Throttle NASCAR Driver Development racer Christian PaHud finished fourth Sunday in the INEX-sanctioned 600 Racing “Battle at Bristol” 40-lap Pro Legends race at Tennessee’s Bristol Motor Speedway. The legends cars raced on the apron of the .533-mile high-banked oval, using the track’s pit roads for the straight-aways.

The INEX legends cars also raced Saturday at Bristol; PaHud was involved in a late-race wreck while running in the top five.

“We had a disappointing day Saturday so we wanted to come out and have a good day today,” the 14-year-old PaHud said Sunday. “We ran third most of the race (Sunday) and I tried to make a pass for second on a restart, missed a shift and ended up fourth. It was a great experience for me. This track is really fast and was a lot of fun to race on this weekend.”

PaHud qualified and started third for Sunday’s 40-lap affair. He initially moved to second before being passed five laps into the race relegating him to third where he ran most of the race before finishing fourth.

“We’re hoping to go to South Boston (Speedway, Va.) in a couple weeks. We want to keep running all the races we can and continue to gain the experience we need,” PaHud added.
