

## CHRISTIAN PAHUD RUNS DOWN LEADER, FINISHES SECOND

Concord, N.C. – Christian PaHud, one of the Team Full Throttle Driver Development Program’s most promising legends car racers, finished a close second Friday night on Concord Motorsport Park’s quarter-mile oval in the INEX Legends Pro class feature.

“We started sixth and fell back at the start,” PaHud began. “After a few laps, the car really started to come in and we worked our way back toward the front. About halfway we got into a small wreck and ripped the right-front fender off the car, but other than that it didn’t hurt the car at all.”

The 14-year-old PaHud spent the final laps of the race running down leader Nick Pistone but ran out of time to make the pass he needed to win his first Concord race of the 2008 season.

“We ran hard at the end, and I thought we might be able to catch him. We did catch him, but just didn’t have enough time to make the pass. I’m still happy; it was a real good night for our Kyle Beattie Racing team.”

The next race for PaHud is this weekend at Tennessee’s Bristol Motor Speedway. It is 600 Racing’s annual “Battle at Bristol” at the high-banked, half-mile oval.
