CHRISTIAN PAHUD TRAVELS SOUTH, FINDS RAIN AND A THIRD

CORDELE, Ga. – Team Full Throttle NASCAR Driver Development legends car racer Christian PaHud had aspirations of a doubleheader last weekend, hoping to compete at Anderson Motor Speedway (S.C.) Friday and Lanier National Speedway (Ga.) Saturday.

Following the trek south, all PaHud's Kyle Beattie Racing INEX legends car team found was rain until they landed at Middle Georgia's three-eighths mile Watermelon Capital Speedway Saturday night. PaHud proceeded to start seventh and finish third in the Watermelon's 20-lap Legends Car feature.

“It was a long trip, but I'm happy we got some racing in,” PaHud, 15, said Sunday. “We were geared for Lanier because that's where we thought we were going to run. When we ended up at Watermelon, we didn't have the gears we needed for the bigger track. I had to shift every lap because of the wrong gears, but it was still pretty fun. If we had the right setup, we would have been better.”

This week, PaHud's team will again try a legends car doubleheader at Anderson Friday and Lanier Saturday. Depending on the circumstances, the team may attempt three races in three days when the legends cars are in action at Concord Motorsport Park on Sunday, April 20.
