

## PAHUD NETS ANOTHER TOP 10 IN WET SHOOTOUT

CONCORD, N.C. – A rainy and wet Tuesday night in the greater Charlotte area had teams scrambling at the Quaker Steak & Lube Summer Shootout at Lowe's Motor Speedway. Faced with a difficult decision as to which tire setup to run, Christian PaHud raced in the Pro Legends car 20-lap feature and finished eighth while battling a "tight" racecar.

"The track was wet and then it started drying and we decided to go with the slick tires," PaHud explained. "It was probably the wrong decision because the car was pushing really bad and the track just didn't dry out as much as we thought it would. We still salvaged an eighth, so we'll take that and focus on next week. It's tough when it rains and then stops; I guess we'll know better for next time."

Before next week's Summer Shootout comes, PaHud and his Kyle Beattie Racing team are planning two weekend events – Friday at Caraway (N.C.) Speedway and Saturday at South Boston Speedway in Virginia.

"We were rained out last week at Caraway so we'll be running a doubleheader there on Friday. South Boston should be fun. I've only raced there once before, so I'll be learning as the night goes on. It's just a normal race up there. We just like travelling to different tracks," says PaHud.

Christian PaHud is a former WKA National Champion. He and his family moved to North Carolina prior to the 2007 racing season and he immediately began winning races in INEX Legends cars. He won the prestigious Summer Shootout Semi-pro Legends championship in 2007 and is currently racing for the Pro Legends car championship in the '08 Summer Shootout.
