

PAHUD PERFECT AT ROCKINGHAM

Harrisburg, N.C. – Team Full Throttle NASCAR Driver Development racer Christian PaHud is on a streak, winning his second INEX Legends Pro class race in a row at North Carolina Speedway's six-turn infield road course Sunday. The 14-year-old Ohio native also overcame a bad start to finish third in Saturday's INEX Legends Pro feature at Lowe's Motor Speedway's infield road course.

PaHud led all 12 laps of the feature at Rockingham on his way to the victory. "We started on the pole after winning our heat," he began. "It was a pretty smooth ride after that. Two in a row at Rockingham is great; we've really enjoyed coming out here the last couple weeks."

While excited about the Rockingham victories, PaHud realizes there is still work to be done closer to home. "There are a few people who have been faster than us at Lowe's recently. I look to that as motivation. We didn't keep up with the changing weather like we should have on Saturday and ended up being really loose in the feature. I think we'll find the right setup this weekend and have a good chance to win."

"This weekend" refers to a Saturday-Sunday Winter Heat series double on the Lowe's Motor Speedway road course for the INEX Legends. PaHud will be looking for his first win of the Winter Heat series at Lowe's following two recent top-five finishes.
