PAHUD EIGHTH TO THIRD FRIDAY AT ANDERSON

WILLIAMSTON, S.C. – Team Full Throttle NASCAR Driver Development racer Christian PaHud started eighth and finished third Friday night in the INEX Legends car Pro class 20-lap feature at Anderson (S.C.) Motor Speedway.

PaHud, 15, who won last week's legends feature at Anderson, had to start last in his 10-car heat race. He made it to fourth in the heat, placing him a fairly deep eighth to start the feature.

“It was an uphill battle all night because at Anderson the last week's feature winner has to start in the back of their heat race,” PaHud explained. “We really didn't have enough time in the races. I think we were the fastest car, but 20 laps aren't long enough to pass seven cars without a few cautions. The competition is tough down here; when we got up to third there were only two laps left.”

PaHud's Kyle Beattie Racing team traveled to Caraway (N.C.) Speedway Saturday night where he was involved in a heavy wreck while running second.

“We got spun around and then someone came in hit our car head on. It's too bad because we probably had the fastest car again (at Caraway). We're hoping to get it fixed before this weekend.

“We've had a good few weeks, but this wasn't one of our best. We'll go for it again this weekend if we can get the car fixed,” PaHud added.

Depending on repairs, PaHud's team is tentatively planning on traveling back to Anderson for their Friday night program and possibly Lanier National Speedway in Braselton, Ga., on Saturday.
