

Top Five Finish Earns PaHud A Trip To The Beach

Harrisburg, NC (November 2, 2009) - Christian PaHud qualified sixth and ran a steady race to finish fifth at the second annual Halloween Havoc 150 for NASCAR Limited Late Models at Tri-County Motor Speedway. With the car in one piece, he is now able to look forward to a trip to the beach.

PaHud, 16, stayed right among the leaders all day, finding himself out front for a few laps before a late-race motor problem slowed his pace a bit.

"Ed Cox and the Orion Motorsports team gave me a really strong car all weekend," PaHud said. "I tried to pace myself early, running in the top five along with my teammate Taylor Doggett. We were running OK and were running for the lead with Tyler Church for a little bit until the motor started missing near the end and we lost some power. We've had the issue before but we just can't isolate it because it doesn't happen all the time, and it unfortunately bit us again. You always hope to win, but we'll take fifth and get ready for the race at Myrtle Beach in November."

The team is looking forward to making their debut at Myrtle Beach Speedway in Myrtle Beach, SC on Saturday November 21st and Sunday, November 22nd for the Limited Late Model portion of the Myrtle Beach 400.
