## **PAHUD 2<sup>ND</sup> IN PRO LEGENDS AT LOWE'S ROAD COURSE, ROCKINGHAM PLANNED FOR THIS WEEKEND**

HARRISBURG, N.C. – Christian PaHud is enjoying a final winter of racing INEX legends cars before moving full time to limited late model stock cars in 2009. PaHud started and finished second in an 8-lap feature at Lowe's Motor Speedway's infield road course Saturday. The race was part of the annual Winter Heat Series at Lowe's for INEX legends cars, bandoleros and thunder roadsters.

“David Ragan started on the pole, I was second and Jimmy Heavlow started third,” Christian began. “I jumped out to the lead but slid up and got into the dirt in one corner and they both got by me. I was able to get back by David but by the time I did that Jimmy was way out front so I just ran in second for the rest of the race. It was good to run on the road course again. It's a fun track.”

PaHud will have another chance to make some right turns this weekend when he and the Kyle Beattie Racing team travel to Rockingham (N.C.) Speedway for legends races on the speedway's infield road course on Saturday and Sunday. PaHud won the Pro Legends feature in The Rock's reopening last winter after being closed for over three years.

The PaHud-driven No. 63 is for sale. Christian will race full time in a limited late model in 2009. His family recently purchased the car from Orion Motorsports and will continue to maintain and field the entry out of Orion's shop in Taylorsville, N.C. PaHud finished fourth in his limited late model debut in November at Tri-County (N.C.) Motor Speedway.

Christian PaHud is one of the top legends car racers in the South who is now making a name for himself in NASCAR limited late models. He and his family moved from Dayton, Ohio, to the greater Charlotte area prior to the 2007 racing season and he immediately began winning races in the legends cars, including the prestigious Summer Shootout semi-pro legends car championship in 2007. He has a handful of oval and road course legends car races planned this winter before moving to limited late models full time in 2009.

PaHud is a member of the Team Full Throttle NASCAR Driver Development Program and is represented by Driver Development Services, Inc., Charlotte, N.C. His marketing partners are Kyle Beattie Racing, RPM Race Cars, and C&S Auto.
