PaHud Finishes Sixth At Tri-County

HUDSON, N.C. (May 1, 2010) -Team Full Throttle driver Christian PaHud started eighth and finished sixth in NASCAR Whelen Weekly Racing Series action at Tri-County Motor Speedway on Friday.

PaHud, who came into this event having won two consecutive races and leading the track points, was disappointed but realistic following his first finish out of the top five this season.
